## Three C's: Character - Conduct - Communication

### Vocabulary for handout

**Media:** Plural of medium, referring to materials used to make art; categories of art (e.g., painting, sculpture, film).

**Imagery:** The use of vivid or figurative language to represent objects, actions, or ideas. The use of expressive or evocative images in art, literature, or music. A group or body of related images, as in a painting or poem. Representative images, particularly statues or icons.

**Guidelines:** 4 separate grades will be issued for various phases of project (Check off dates when completed)

- Develop concepts for your selected word. (Character, Conduct, or Communication) **(Not graded)**
- Create at least 4 thumbnail rough drafts for your chosen word **Due 9/17/09**
- At least 1 fleshed out rough draft for the selected word **Due 9/21/09**
- Complete final Word Art utilizing any media available (Ink, water color, color pencils, etc) **Due 9/25/09**
- Reflection Paper (Separate handout with rubric) **Due 9/28/09**

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## Three C's: Character - Conduct - Communication

**Character:** good repute; "he is a man of character." Reputation, repute - the state of being held in high esteem and honor. A set of qualities that are considered admirable in some way

**Conduct:** The way a person acts, especially from the standpoint of morality and ethics. Behavioral attributes: the way a person behaves toward other people

**Communication:** The exchange of thoughts, messages, or information, as by speech, signals, writing, or behavior.

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
